

Committee Membership and Activities

Planning and Steering Committee

Membership shall be limited to executive members. The committee shall serve on behalf of the board of directors. An executive subcommittee shall prepare proposals on policies, details on activities, budgets, etc. and submit these proposals to the committee.

Technical Committee

Membership shall be open to executive members and full members. The committee shall discuss MCPC's technical problems and come up with the best solutions, from the perspective of technological advances, while respecting the opinions of the members. A terminal working group, center systems (middleware, software, networks) working group, and verify various technical issues as well as to develop relevant hardware or software. The committee shall have a deep understanding of each working group's technical issues and actively participate in resolving the issues.

802.11 Committee

The committee shall conduct research and application evaluations concerning 802.1X, and extract problems and break them down into concrete contents of activities that lead to various other activities. The committee shall also conduct research on the latest technologies in foreign countries.

Bluetooth Committee

As the only Bluetooth promotion organization in Japan, the committee shall conduct research on the latest and most detailed technologies, and perform their promotion, educational activities, and interoperability tests (implementation) for each category. The committee shall also explore the application of Bluetooth to new fields. The committee is tied up with the U.S. SIG and is beginning examination of the UWB specifications.

Promotion and Marketing Committee

The committee shall contribute technical and marketing circumstances of mobile computing systems to promote and popularize it by:

- Promoting case studies of MCPC member companies at an annual ceremony in the MCPC.
 - The MCPC award
- Holding a trade show in Japan
 - The PDA & Mobile Solution Fair (in autumn)
- Supporting start-up companies to get started business in Japan
 - The Start-up Business Support Program
- Supporting companies to utilize a mobile computing system to their business.
 - Practical seminars in association with chamber of commerce and industry
